

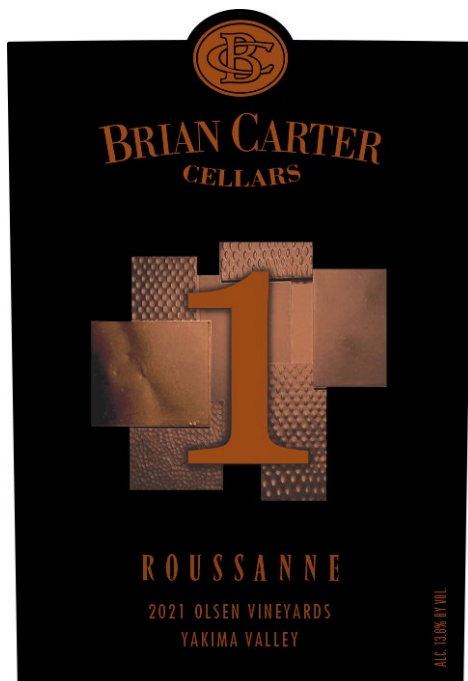


2021 Roussanne

The Brian Carter Cellars ONE program is exceptional lots of wine that ‘escape’ from my passionate will to blend. While we have been making small amounts of ONE wines under a dozen varieties since 2007. This is the second Olsen Roussanne we have released. The Roussanne grape is found in the Hermitage and Chateauneuf de Pape regions of the Rhone Valley of France where it is used in blends but rarely made into a varietal wine. In Washington State the wine has risen to varietal status among several wineries who realize its outstanding character.

A light gold color in the glass, on the nose this wine has a ‘fruit salad’ mix of honeydew melon, pears, lemons and figs. The wine has a mouth filling body with flavors of Bosc pear. Excellent with a variety of white fish I recommend serving this wine with Halibut or Sole in a lemon cream sauce.
