We source the majority of the grapes from cooler areas of the Yakima Valley. The classic vintage of 2019 shows off generous aromatic elements and a classic Chianti-like finish.

Close your eyes when you put your nose to the glass. Picture yourself walking through the early fall woods of Tuscany; it has rained the day before and there is a hint of white truffles in the air. Wild ripe blackberries line the pathway, and the perfume of late season flowers reaches your nose. Take a sip and imagine yourself seated in your favorite candle-lit Italian restaurant. The zesty finish makes it the perfect combination for tomato-based dishes or salmon. Now, open your eyes to **TUTTOROSSO**.

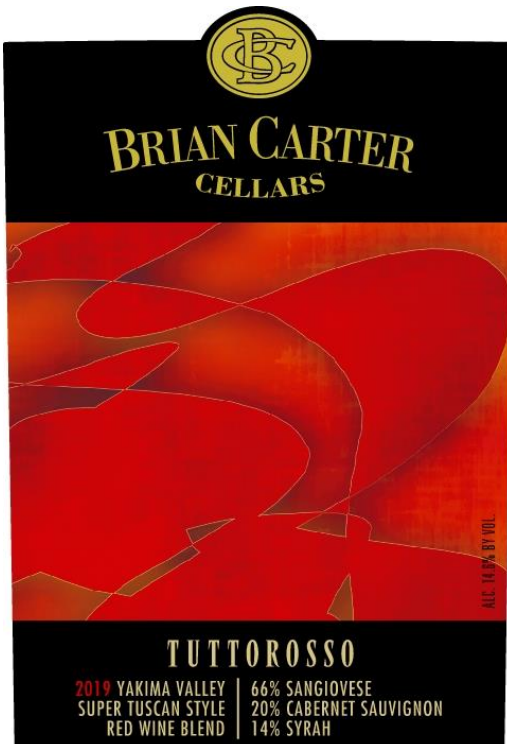
