

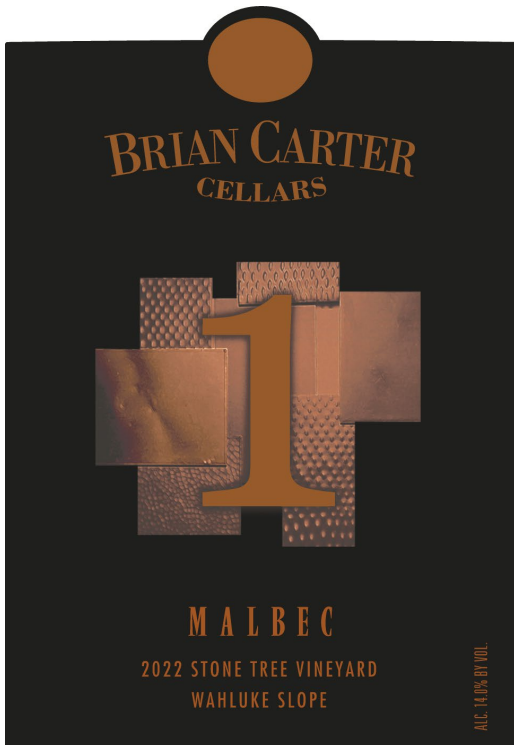


## 2022 MALBEC

Stone Tree Vineyards  
Wahluke Slope AVA

This is the third ONE Malbec we have produced but the first from Stone Tree and the first we have made since 2010. Malbec is one of the classic Bordeaux varieties but has found a perfect home in the new world where wines from Argentina have made the biggest mark. Washington Malbecs are distinctively great and deserve a spot on the world stage. One of the darkest wines you can find, with a distinct varietal character.

**Tasting Notes:** Impenetrably dark in color, the intense and complex interplay of aromas includes blackberry, blueberry, damson plums with hints of thyme, tobacco, and toasted oak. Flavors are generous with ripe supple tannins, balanced acidity and a lengthy finish suggesting a wine that will improve with age. Drink with beef, lamb or wild game prepared with reduced wine sauce and a blueberry relish.
