

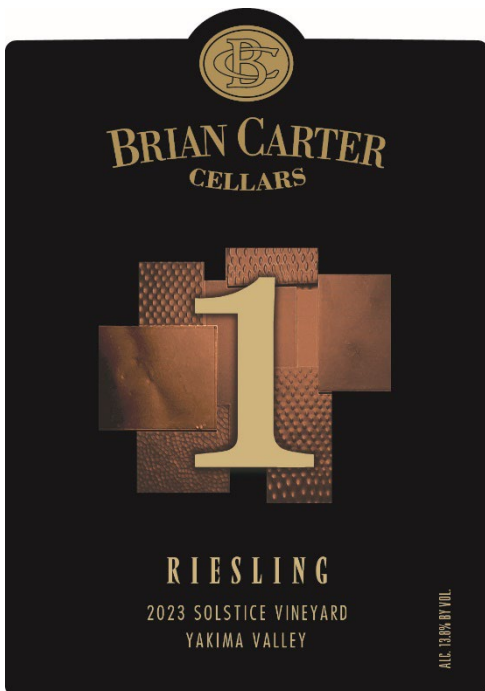


2023 Riesling

The Brian Carter Cellars ONE program is exceptional lots of wine that 'escape' from my passionate will to blend. Riesling is considered to be one of the four classic wine grapes in the world along with Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, and Chardonnay. Once the largest planted grape in the State, Washington is still well known for Riesling around the world. This Riesling was grown in a 45-year-old block located in the heart of the Yakima Valley at the Solstice Vineyard owed by Jim and Carla Willard. I have been purchasing grapes from this vineyard for over 35 years.

Showing a pretty golden hue, this wine has plenty of bright fruit highlighted by green apples, juicy fruit and a bit of feminine perfume. As the wine enters your mouth you get a good grip of acidity followed by clean fruit and just the slightest hint of sweetness as you swallow. Keep this in your cellar for even greater rewards!
