




## 2024 Sauvignon Blanc

*Solstice Vineyard  
Yakima Valley AVA*

The Brian Carter Cellars ONE program celebrates lots of wine that ‘escape’ from my passionate will to blend. This is Brian Carter Cellars’ first release of Sauvignon Blanc, one of the world’s great white wine grapes which has risen to become a mainstay in Washington State. This Sauvignon Blanc block is located in the heart of the Yakima Valley at the Solstice Vineyard owned by Jim and Carla Willard. I have been purchasing grapes from them for over 35 years.

Showing a pretty golden hue, the wine has aromas of fresh basil, oregano and dill, with a touch of orange peel. On the palate: bright acidity with flavors of fresh herbs and citrus and some richness on the finish. Serve this wine with shellfish, my favorite would be oysters on the half shell right off the beach!
