




2023 Tempranillo

Because of the success of Corrida, Tempranillo has become one of the most important varieties at Brian Carter Cellars. This grape has a special place for me because I visited so many vineyards in Spain where it was the King! This is our second Tempranillo under the ONE label, both of them from the Stone Tree Vineyard. Stone Tree has been our most reliable producer of Tempranillo for over two decades and this selection shows again how great the wine can be.

Tasting Notes: Dark garnet in color, the wine has a complex nose of blackberry, blueberry, toast and black pepper spice. On the palate the wine is full and complex with outstanding structure and length. Try it with grilled pork ribs marinated in your favorite sauce (include red wine).
