




2024 DÉsir
(French for Desire)
Bordeaux Style White Blend
Yakima Valley AVA

This is the second version in what is the second white wine blend to complement our much-enjoyed Oriana. Again in 2024, I chose to make what has become a Washington State classic using the dominant white Bordeaux varieties Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc. A beautiful light golden color in the glass the aroma has notes of ripe pears, figs and herbs with a touch of lanolin. On the palate are similar flavors with bright acidity and a long finish. Enjoy with scallops sautéed with basil, parsley and garlic.

Fermentation

One third barrel fermented in neutral French Oak barrels, two thirds stainless steel fermented. Both kept on lees and stirred monthly for 6 months to increase mouth feel and aromatic complexity. No malolactic fermentation (MLF) was conducted.
